- MD/PhD's are exempt from the ABS requirement (both the ABS course and the research/teaching requirement.) MD/PhD's are exempt from the elective requirement.
- Students who hold a PhD in the biomedical sciences are also exempt from the ABS requirement (both the ABS course and the ABS research/teaching requirement.) They must take 16 weeks of electives and a sub-I in Medicine or Pediatrics.
- If a student has a PhD in a non-Biomedical Science area -- such as Physics, the student must fulfill all aspects of the ABS requirement.
- All exemptions require the approval of Dr. Pardee (see below).
- No SUBSTITUTION will be accepted in place of the courses from which students are excused.

* Note: You may apply research or teaching experience toward fulfillment of either the ABS requirement or the 16 credits of electives, NOT BOTH, except in the case of those electing to do 8 weeks of BS research in the third/fourth year. For those students, this option will both meet the ABS requirement and may also be applied as 4 credits toward the 16 elective credits that are required.

** Note: Completion of activity I, II or III does not exempt the student from the ABS course.
