The Division of Health Policy in the Department of Public Health at Weill Medical College of Cornell University is seeking a faculty member at the Instructor or Assistant Professor level to join our academic research group in New York City. The Division studies the efficient and equitable allocation of scarce health care resources, focusing on health care technology assessment and comparative effectiveness, disparities in treatment and preventive care, financing and reimbursement, and incentives for implementation of evidence-based practice.

We are seeking a new faculty member planning a career in externally-funded, clinically-oriented health policy research in an academic medical center environment. The successful candidate's research plans should include a substantial focus on technology assessment, comparative effectiveness, and cost-effectiveness studies of radiologic techniques (including, but not limited to imaging for screening and diagnosis; imaging as a biomarker; image guided interventions; and imaging to improve the diagnosis and delivery of medical or surgical treatments). The faculty member will work as a member of interdisciplinary research teams with faculty of the Department of Public Health, colleagues from the Department of Radiology and other clinical departments at Weill Medical College, relevant basic science and policy departments at Cornell, Ithaca, and clinicians at the New York Presbyterian Hospital and Healthcare System. The position will include participation in the education and mentoring of medical students, residents, fellows, graduate students and post-doctoral fellows in the Departments of Public Health and Radiology.

Successful candidates will have received a doctorate in health services research, economics, decision science, public health, or a related field by July 1, 2012. Candidates must have a demonstrated record of successful quantitative research related to clinically-oriented health policy and strong potential for obtaining external funding. The ideal candidate will have experience conducting academic research in collaboration with clinical investigators and a record of peer-reviewed publications. Candidates with previous research experience and publications in the field of Radiology are strongly encouraged.

The faculty member will be appointed to the faculty of the Weill Cornell Medical College in the Department of Public Health as an Instructor or Assistant Professor (depending on experience). The faculty member will also have a secondary appointment in the Department of Radiology.
